



CIHOL Fellowships: Call for Ph.D. students

The Centre for International Humanitarian and Operational Law (CIHOL) is pleased to announce the opening of **two partially funded doctoral positions** for students seeking to undertake their Ph.D. studies at the Palacký University Faculty of Law within the primary areas of focus of the Centre, broadly construed within the fields of international conflict and security law and international humanitarian law.

Candidates interested in pursuing a Ph.D. within the following areas are particularly encouraged to apply:

- International law and sanctions regimes
- Law of armed conflict and international environmental law
- Cyberspace and international conflict and security law
- AI and international law

Successful candidates will be employed on a **part-time basis** within the Centre from the beginning of their studies until **31 December 2025**. Subject to the availability of additional funding, employment may be extended beyond this period.

Expected start date: **1 September 2024** (subject to enrolment of the student in a Ph.D. programme at the Law Faculty)
